



LOLA meeting: July 8, 2017

Meeting called to order @ 9:00

Officers Present: Patti Powell; Steve Powell; Paul Duran; Ray Bolton; Karen Lord; Dave Prinsen

Officers Absent: Scott Dixon; Bill Phillips

June minutes were read and approved.

OLD BUSINESS: Price quote for deck was \$7000 for materials. Paul suggested sending letter and Go Fund Me to see if donations could be taken. Others agreed. Ray suggested making a list of projects, including the roof and clearing for a better view of the lake, with estimates and prioritizing the need. Ray said his neighbor can get a big brush hog and clear the area to the lake for \$250.

A vote was taken on the brush hog work and it passed for Ray's neighbor, Matt, to do the work for \$250.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Read and approved.

TOWNSHIP REPORT: Clean-up day went really fast.

CLUBHOUSE REPORT: Thanks to Ray and his wife for washing the windows. The dock still needs connector in the middle. It needs to be fixed from the underside, so it probably won't be done until next year. All of the winter hazards have been removed. When the dock is removed it will be left at the lake side and secured to a tree, rather than brought up to clubhouse.

ACTIVITIES:

HAPPY HOUR: Next one is July 21 and will be a fish fry with fish left from last month. Volunteers should be at clubhouse at 5:30.

NEW BUSINESS: Mike texted a friend on getting the water tested and has not yet had a response, according to Foley. Ray noted that the water was much clearer after the rain, but there are still some large weed beds.

Maston Lake water level is up under the bridge and there is a permit to have something done that may affect Blue Lake. Someone on Maston has applied for a grant to dredge the lake system. Steve did not have all of the details. The person was invited to come to the meeting to talk about it. He has not yet made arrangements to do that.

There has been some county activity at the dam and Cedar Lake, according to Foley and Dave. They are not sure what is going on.

We need to accept nominations for president, Prinsen and Bolton trustees. All three are willing to run again.
