TREASURER'S REPORT:

CLUBHOUSE REPORT:

Air conditioners need to be put in. Windows need to be painted or wrapped in aluminum. Ray suggested just to paint. Pam suggested waterproof stain. Pam suggested we table this discussion until June. Propane is at 40%. Scott has a cylinder he will store until we can switch it out next year when we change propane providers. We are currently renting at \$160.00 yearly.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was a discussion regarding the rental of the clubhouse. In February it was rented and this was very expensive as we had to turn the gas on and winterize it afterwards. Rental must be a donation. We recommend \$50.00 but cannot require a certain amount. There was discussion regarding changing the spigot on the water tank/main valve because the winterization process is difficult with it being on the floor.



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We need to raise the plumbing. Snow plowing and ice is also an issue for winter rental. Pam made a motion that we no longer rent during the winter. Ray seconded the motion. We will only rent from April 1 – October 31.

ACTIVITIES:

Pam is setting up the Boater Safety class possibly June 19. She will contact those that signed up last year first. We need a minimum of 25 people. Tom Stressman of Woodbeck may be interested in a second class.

Pam will order the pulled pork for the picnic. \$73.00 to serve 50 people. Sages in Greenville will be used.

Ray reports Maston Lake fish planting of 6,150 Walleye in 22 years. DNR is limiting us to 300 this year. Maybe we can plant Perch or another species next year.

June 12-13 is free fishing.
