**NEW BUSINESS:**

Paul brought up the issue of donating money to M & M Environmental Lake Association for the fish stocking. We can only plant 300 walleye this year and we have additional monies that can be used. 25% of the amount of M&M cost to do the fish planting would be \$450.00. Paul suggested we donate \$500.00. Jan seconded that suggestion. We unanimously agreed. Ray stated he has the approved permit for 300 walleye at a cost of \$866.00 for us to plant in Blue and Black Lakes. We are good to
